San Diego Country Club was founded in 1897. Our first club house, constructed in 1921, has been designated a San Diego historic site. Our current club house, completed in 1988, is our social-center hub — a comfortable, relaxing place featuring our formal dining room with a bird's-eye view of our exquisite grounds, the Billy Casper Grill and the Mickey Wright Lounge filled with the club's historical memorabilia.

San Diego Country Club has been a distinctive part of San Diego's golfing history for more than a century. We are the oldest country club in San Diego and the only private course in southern San Diego County, an easy 15-minute drive from downtown, Coronado or East Lake.

Our renowned, championship-caliber course, designed by William P. Bell, was built in 1921, before bulldozers were used. The result is a rolling terrain that makes every shot different from the one before.

Pros look forward to our Augusta-like greens. Enthusiasts welcome the challenge of playing all types of golf shots here. And everyone, including men, women, couples and youths, enjoys easy accessibility for play with our array of planned golfing events.

We hosted the 1952 and '53 PGA San Diego Open; the 1964 USGA Women's Open Championship and the 1993 US Women's Amateur Championship won by Jill McGill.
